

A MESSAGE FROM ST. PAUL'S HOSPITAL REGARDING

301 HILLIARD STREET EAST

Owned by the Bishops of Saskatchewan through Emmanuel Care, St. Paul's Hospital leads Palliative Care and Hospice Services and houses the only Palliative Care Unit in the Saskatoon area. Since the opening of the Palliative Care Unit nearly 30 years ago, St. Paul's has been working to establish a residential hospice in Saskatoon. A hospice is a respectful, comfortable and home-like facility for patients facing end of life who do not require hospital care, but are unable to be cared for in their own home.

In 2014, St. Paul's Hospital learned of the availability of the former Ursuline Sisters of Prelate residence and investigated its potential use as a Hospice. The quiet neighbourhood with nearby parks is ideally suited to a hospice. Investigation of the building structure and city zoning also proved to be positive for the establishment of a hospice.

In 2015, St. Paul's Hospital purchased the property at 301 Hilliard Street East and we are proceeding with the development of the hospice. The Hospital is currently in the planning stages and will be doing minor, non-invasive exploratory work on the property the beginning of May, 2018.

We apologize for any noise pollution or other inconvenience this equipment may cause.

We are excited to be working to fill this service gap in the community and look forward to becoming a part of the Queen Elizabeth community! Further details of the Hospital's plan will be forthcoming in the New Year.
